Theoretical part of the theses describes the foundations of the warehouse management system. However, it is very brief with extent of 17 pages. One chapter from the practical part (analysis of the chosen organization) is insert into the theoretical part. The literature sources are not quoted in the theoretical part of the theses.*

*Practical part contain financial analysis and ABC analysis of the company. The main goal of the practical part is to determine the efficiency using selected inventory methods for the chosen company. Student suggests some improvements in organization warehouse operations. Overall, this thesis fulfilled its aims.*
